RESOLUTION 9 OF 1999

Formation of sectoral bargaining forums for Health and Welfare and General Public Service

1. Aims

The parties to the PSCBC agree to negotiate relevant issues in sectoral bargaining forums for Health and Welfare and General Public Service according to their Constitutions, except for the issues that parties could not resolve in the Constitution, which this agreement will regulate.

2. Scope

2.1. This agreement applies to the employer and employees:

- (a) who are employed by the State, and
- (b) who fall within the registered scope of the PSCBC.

3. Date of implementation

This agreement shall, in respect of parties and non-parties, come into operation on the date it is signed in the PSCBC.

4. Operation of sectoral bargaining forums for Health and Welfare and for the General Public Service


- 4.1. The parties agree to negotiate in sectoral bargaining forums for Health and Welfare and the General Public Service in accordance with the constitutions for these sectors submitted to the Registrar of Labour Relations except as provided in paragraph 4.2.
- 4.2. A party that is represented in the PSCBC and has members covered by the scope of a sectoral bargaining forum may participate in the forum.
- 4.3. This agreement shall not influence a final decision on unresolved points in the draft Constitutions of the Health and Welfare or the General Public Service Sectoral Bargaining Councils.
- 4.4. An agreement concluded in a sectoral bargaining forum shall constitute a binding agreement of the PSCBC.



